CHAPTER 1

LOCAL LAW NO. 16 OF 2016

A LOCAL LAW ENTITLED ADMINISTRATION

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SHOREHAM, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this local law is to enact an administration local law.

SECTION 2. ENACTMENT.

A Chapter 1 of the Village Code entitled Administration is enacted, as follows:

§ 1-1. Village Local Laws.

§ 1-2. Repeal of Local Laws not Included in the Village Code.

Any Village local law in force on the effective date of this local law and not contained in the Village Code, or not recognized and continued in force by reference therein, are hereby repealed from and after the effective date of this local law.

§ 1-3. Enactments Saved from Repeal/Matters not Affected.

The repeal of local laws as provided in § 1-2 of this Chapter 1 shall not affect any of the following classes of local laws, ordinances, rights or obligations, which are hereby expressly saved from repeal.

- (1) Right or liability established, accrued or incurred under any legislative provision of the Village prior to the effective date of this local law, or any action or proceeding brought for the enforcement of such right or liability.
- (2) Offense or act committed or done before the effective date of this local law in violation of any legislative provision of the Village, or any penalty, punishment or forfeiture which may result therefrom.
- (3) Prosecution, indictment, action, suit or other proceeding pending, or any judgment rendered prior to the effective date of this local law, brought pursuant to any legislative provision of the Village.

- (4) Franchise, license, right, easement or privilege heretofore granted or conferred by the Village.
- (5) Local law or ordinance of the Village providing for the laying out, opening, altering, widening, relocating, straightening, establishing the grade, changing the name, improvement, acceptance or vacation of any right-of-way, easement, street, road, park or other public place within the Village or any portion thereof.
- (6) Local law or ordinance of the Village appropriating money or transferring funds, promising or guaranteeing the payment of money or authorizing the issuance and delivery of any bond of the Village or other instruments or evidence of the Village's indebtedness.
- (7) Local law, ordinance or resolution authorizing the purchase, sale, lease or transfer of property, or any lawful contract or obligation.
 - (8) Levy or imposition of special assessments or charges.
 - (9) Dedication of property.
 - (10) Legislation relating to salaries.

§ 1-4. Copy of the Village Code on File.

A copy of the Village Code has been filed in the office of the Clerk and shall remain there for use and examination by the public, and such copy shall be certified to by the Clerk by impressing thereon the seal of the Village, and such certified copy shall remain on file in the office of said clerk to be made available to persons desiring to examine same.

§ 1-5. Amendments to the Village Code.

Any and all additions, deletions, amendments or supplements to any of the local laws constituting the Village Code, or any new local law, when enacted or adopted in such form as to indicate the intention of the Village Board to be a part thereof, shall be deemed to be incorporated into said code so that reference to same shall be understood and intended to include such additions, deletions, amendments or supplements. Whenever such additions, deletions, amendments or supplements shall be enacted or adopted, they shall thereafter be incorporated into said code. Nothing contained in this Chapter 1 shall affect the status of any other local law contained in the Village Code, and such local laws, ordinances and resolutions may be amended, deleted or changed from time-to-time in such manner as is provided by law for the amendment of local laws.

§ 1-6. Code Book to be Kept Up-to-Date.

It shall be the duty of the Clerk to keep up-to-date the certified copy of the book containing the Village Code required to be filed in the office of said clerk for use by the public. All changes in said code and all local laws adopted by the Village Board subsequent to the enactment of this local law in such form as to indicate the intention of said board to be a part of said code shall, when finally enacted, be included therein by attachment of copies of such changes or local laws.

§ 1-7. Changes in Previously Adopted Legislation.

In compiling and preparing the local laws set forth in § 1-1 of this Chapter 1, no changes in the meaning or intent of such laws have been made, except for certain grammatical changes and other minor nonsubstantive changes, including numeric and lettering references, that have been made in one or more of said laws, it being the intention of the Village Board that all such changes be adopted as part of the Village Code as if such local laws had been previously formally amended to read as such.

§ 1-8. Continuation of Existing Provisions.

The provisions of the Village Code, insofar as they are substantively the same as those of local laws, ordinances and resolutions in force immediately prior to the enactment of the said code by this local law, as set forth in § 1-1 of this Chapter 1, are intended as a continuation of such local laws, ordinances and resolutions and not as new enactments, and the effectiveness of such provisions shall date from the date of adoption of the prior local law, ordinance or resolution.

§ 1-9. Severability.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section, article or part of this local law or of any other local law cited in \$\sigma\$ 1-1 of this Chapter 1 shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section, article or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State as provided by law.
